To Calculate Meals and Lodging Costs at the Academy

For meals and lodging at the Academy, multiply the number in the **M/L** column (*Meals and Lodging*) by \$40. For **meals only**, multiply the number by \$17.
Example: If the M/L number is 2, meals and lodging would be \$80; meals only would be \$34. This payment can be made upon arrival.
